



The Catholic Women's League of Victoria & Wagga Wagga Ballarat Diocesan Committee warmly invites you to a lecture about the life of Dr Sr Mary Glowrey JMJ and a celebration of 97 years of dedicated service by CWL Ballarat Cathedral Branch.

Born in the small township of Birregurra in 1887, Mary Glowrey became a pioneering doctor and worked in some of Melbourne's leading hospitals.

In 1920, she sailed for India where she joined the Congregation of the Society of Jesus Mary Joseph (JMJ) in Guntur, becoming the first nun-doctor missionary.

She placed the remainder of her life at the service of the medical and spiritual needs of the people of India, as an expression of her own deeply held love for God and for humanity. In 2013, Mary Glowrey was declared a Servant of God. She is only the second Australian on the official path to canonisation.
