On Wednesday 10 May 2023, the ACT Government announced that it would compulsorily acquire Calvary Public Hospital in Canberra. The Hospital is an apostolic work of the Little Company of Mary. There has been considerable commentary on the ACT Government's action, as well as sustained media interest. Archbishop Prowse has called for the decision to be revisited and has established a taskforce, to challenge the ACT Government's plan.
