# An Easter with a Special Anniversary

(Part of Bishop Paul's Easter Message)

This Easter, our diocese will be marking a special anniversary.

It was on March 30 1874, that Pope Pius IX issued a decree establishing the Diocese of Ballarat.

The 150th anniversary will occur on March 30, which in 2024 happens to be Holy Saturday. When we celebrate the Easter Vigil this year, we might well remember that the risen Jesus has been with us as a diocesan community for the past 150 years. He has been with us through the joys and struggles of these years and he promises to remain with us always.

### The Paschal Candle

The Paschal Candle represents Christ, the Light of the World.

The pure beeswax of which the Candle is made represents the sinless Christ who was formed in the womb of his Mother. The wick signifies his humanity, the flame his Divine Nature.

During the Easter Vigil the minister carries the Candle in procession into the darkened Church. Then the peoples' tapers are lit and the Church is suddenly full of light. The Candle is lit during the 50 days of the Easter Season.

During the year the Candle is lit for baptism and

funeral services; it is placed next to the coffin during the funeral Mass. In this way it symbolizes baptism as a death and resurrection in Christ, and also testifies to Christian hope in the resurrection. The Easter Candle is lit each day during Mass throughout the Paschal Season. After Pentecost it is left next to the baptismal font.

My intention, in the symbolism on the Candle, is to show how the Resurrection of Christ triumphs over suffering and death. The colour of purple recedes and gives way to the vibrant reds and gold symbolism of the Resurrection. (Mareta – the artist)
