I have very much enjoyed being among you for about four months since September 2016, even though that short time was divided by a spell in hospital. It has been a privilege to share your Sunday worship and occasional other events like funerals and children's sacraments, and especially your friendship.

Unfortunately, my time here has to end, for the peritonitis that I suffered in early 2016 has left my heart beating erratically. While it is stable at the moment, it is still rather slow, and the medication that maintains it leaves me with only about 25% of the energy I would normally have. Living here at a distance from my doctor is a bit risky, especially when ordinary activities demand more effort than they normally would.

You have been very generous and kind to me: the presbytery is excellently maintained and had more than I needed. Often I had plenty of reason to admire the good team-work with which you manage and run the parish. You have the Holy Spirit working in and among you!

I'll continue to pray for you all; I'd be grateful if you would occasionally do the same for me Sincerely
