ROYAL COMMISSION

Following the final report issued by the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse, Bishop Paul Bird has written a letter concerning measures already in place. They include:

- improvement & implementation of child protection policies & procedures across parishes, schools & catholic agencies
- appointment of a diocesan professional standards coordinator

.

- appointment of a safeguarding officer for all parishes, schools & agencies
- review of past settlements with survivors to ensure the settlements are fair
- developing a more professional & holistic approach to supporting survivors
- implementing a school curriculum that seeks to empower children & young people to have a voice in their education & to enhance their personal safety.

The next stage of responding to the findings of the Royal Commission for the diocese of Ballarat will include:

- participation as a diocesan community in an audit by Catholic Professional Standards of how we are implementing the safeguarding standards they have established. This is likely to be held before the end of 2018
- engagement with local survivors & their health professionals, seeking their feedback on how we are responding to the Reports recommendations
- trialling of a new approach to the governance of parish schools
- continuing to explore ways in which we can provide pastoral & practical assistance to survivors and their families.
