Parish Update: We are preparing to return to our Sunday Eucharist but the experience will be somewhat different.

- We are required to limit the number of people at Mass
- There is the cleaning of the whole church between Masses
- We have to observe the one person per 4 sq metre rule
- Names and ph numbers of attendees must be recorded (for contact tracing)
- Parishioners to call the Parish Office to register for Mass as there will probably be more people desiring to attend than there are places. We desire to ensure equity and a 'fair go' to enable as many people as possible the opportunity to participate in the celebration of the Eucharist.
- Collection plates may be a thing of the past (see below)
- Hymn books may also be a thing of the past
- We will need to find alternate ways in sharing the 'Sign of Peace'
- Communion to be given in the hand only and no drinking from the Cup
- Hands to be sanitised on entering the Gathering Space

This is why we are proceeding slowly and with caution. We will continue to 'live-stream' until Masses resume on a regular basis. (Fr John)
