DECREE

Warrnambool East joined to South West Coast Parish

After consulting the priests and parishioners of the parishes involved, as well as the Council of Priests of the Diocese of Ballarat, by virtue of Canon 515 par. 2 of the Code of Canon Law, I hereby dissolve the Parish of Our Lady Help of Christians, Warrnambool East, and join the territory that belonged to that parish with the territory of Star of the Sea Parish, South West Coast, to form an extended Star of the Sea Parish, South West Coast.
