Note from the Bishop

For the five days of the lockdown, all places of worship in Victoria are closed for private worship or religious ceremonies.

A place of worship may host a funeral, but attendance will be limited to 10 people plus staff.

Weddings are not permitted indoors or outdoors unless one or both people getting married are at the end of life or would otherwise be deported. In these exceptional cases, only five people can attend the wedding – the couple being married, two wit-

nesses and the celebrant.

During these days of lockdown, we will not be able to gather for worship as we usually do. However, we can still pray in our homes. I encourage you in your personal prayer and your prayer as a family.
