Plenary Council

The last of the six themes that have extracted from people's submissions to the preparatory committee for the Council suggests that the Church should be open to conversion, renewal and reform. Respondents expressed a desire to do things differently in response to Christ and the experience of people. Some asked for a consideration of alternative approaches to ordained ministry; others looked for a greater inclusion of laity and different groups in the Church's life, with new models of governance and leadership. Some mentioned a renewed call to holiness and called for the Third Rite of Reconciliation to be restored. Much more information can be had at plenarycouncil.catholic.org.au
