<u>Saint of the Week – St Vincent, deacon,</u> <u>martyr (January 22)</u>

Born at Huesca, Spain, he became a deaand served St Valerius con at Saragossa until their martvrdom at Valencia during the persecutions under Emperor Diocletian (r. 284-305). St Valerius was exiled, but Vincent was cruelly tortured because he would not surrender the holy books. He converted the warden of the prison and then died. He was honored by Sts Augustine, Pope Leo I, and Prudentius, and is considered the patron saint of vinedressers in some regions of Spain.
