Bishop Paul Bird writes

..... 'to counter the renewed spread of COVID-19 Stage 3 restrictions apply

from midnight August 5th until September 13th. The regulations require that religious ceremonies and private worship be **broadcast only**.

In regional Victoria, there may only be 5 people for a wedding and up to 10 people for a funeral (plus those conducting the funeral).

It is very sad that we will not be able to gather for Mass in the coming weeks. However, medical advice indicates that the restrictions are necessary for the health of the community. I hope and pray that these steps will be effective in reducing the impact of the pandemic and that we will be able to come together again soon to give thanks to God.

In the meantime, we can pray anywhere and anytime in our own heart. Families can pray together at home. We might also pray with others online or simply with a phone call.

Christ promised to be with us always. May we know his presence in the weeks ahead'.

First Eucharist: This sacrament is for Year 4 students who have been baptised and confirmed. First Eucharist will be run a little differently this year, with children working through the material with their parents at home, rather than the group meetings at school. Please keep the children and their families in your prayers as they begin to prepare for this sacrament.
