The Synod of the Catholic Church

Pope Francis points to eight characteristics of a synodal church. We will examine one each week.

Journeying Together:

Synodality points to the reality that the whole of People of God are journeying together. This means that we cannot operate from a mindset that concentrates on the differences amongst the baptised. Rather, we must view ourselves as a people united in faith and in the knowledge that God is calling us to a common pilgrimage on this earth.

Ministers of Holy Communion to the Sick and Housebound

The manner of acquiring Holy Communion during mass for distribution to the sick and housebound has been standardised across the church communities

Could ministers please bring their pyx into the sacristy and place it on the tray provided, putting the required number of altar breads for consecration into the pyx.

After the distribution of Holy Communion during mass the priest will invite ministers to the foot of the bottom step of the sanctuary to retrieve their pyx and receive a blessing.

For those who have mobility issues your pyx will be available for collection in the sacristy at the conclusion of mass.
