may be accustomed to think of Advent as the time en we prepare for the coming of God, but the reads also train our attention on our own journey to God. see this most clearly in this first Sunday with readings It tell us the identity of the pilgrims, the destination vard which they travel, and the way of life that is uired of them on their journey. As the Vatican uncil has proclaimed: We are a pilgrim people.

h the reading from Isaiah and the psalm response ak of the pilgrimage to the mountain of the Lord, the ce where God can be found. Although the psalm aks about Jerusalem and refers to the temple there, broader theological significance of the mountain, city and the temple is one and the same. They resent the presence of God in our midst, and this sence is the goal of our striving. There are clear ections about how we are to live while we are on this rimage to God. In Isaiah we learn that we must put ay our instruments of violence and hatred, our ords and our spears. Lest we pick them up again, we told to convert them into life-producing implements. ploughs and pruning hooks. Paul exhorts us to put ay our deeds of darkness and self-indulgence and to the ourselves instead in the deeds of Jesus Christ. thew points out the need for alertness, attentivess, a disposition that is open to a change of heart ______
