The Forty Days of Lent

Last Wednesday (Ash Wednesday) is one of our most sacred days. It's the commencement of our forty (40) days journey to the glory of Easter.

We may think 40 days is a long time ... and it is. But good habits take time and the 40 days also symbolises God's patience with us.

Forty is a most significant number in our biblical tradition:

- Noah and the Ark: it rained for 40 days and nights and then life returned ... more purified
- The Israelites, after being freed from Egypt, took 40 years to cross the desert to reach the Promised Land
- Jesus fasted for 40 days in the wilderness where he was tempted
- Moses met with God in the cloud on Mount Sinai. He stayed there for 40 days and nights (Exodus 24:18)
- The prophet Elijah travelled for 40 days until be reached Horeb, the mountain of God ... and he heard God in the sound of a gently breeze (1 Kings 19:8)
- The people of Nineveh took 40 days to repent of their sins
- Jesus spent 40 days with his people following his crucifixion and resurrection and prior to his ascension (Acts 1:3)

The season of Lent is a time of prayer, self-denial and for helping others. In this way the whole Church prepares for Easter
