### **Catholic Customs**

It is customary to bless ourselves with holy water on entering the church (that is, the building); it is a reminder that it was through the sacrament of water that we entered the Church (that is, the community of faith). Holy Water (water the priest has blessed, usually in the presence of a congregation) is often sprinkled on people, places and things in token of a blessing - that is, the Church's prayer-being offered for the person or thing being blessed. At the end of life, holy water is used to bless our coffins and our graves.
