Is It Year A, B or C?

How do you know if the year's readings are from Year A, B or C? It's guite easy! The legal fiction is that the Year 1 AD was year A. the Year 2 AD was Year B and the Year 3 AD, Year C. Then 4 AD was A again, 5 AD, B again and 6 AD Year C again. It follows that the Year C (such as 2016 or 2019) is always exactly divisible by 3, and if it is, the digits of the Year, when added together, are also exactly divisible by 3. So 2+0+1+6=9 and 2+0+1+9=12 and 9 and 12 are exactly divisible by 3, so the years 2016 and 2019 are Year C. Therefore the liturgical year 2017 was Year A and 2018 will be Year B (always remembering that the liturgical year begins on the first Sunday of Advent, which is usually in late November or early December.)

As to weekdays, even years (such as 2018) are Year 2 and odd years (such as 2017) are Year 1.
