#### **The Advent Wreath**



The Advent wreath is a Christian tradition that symbolises the passage of the four weeks of Advent in the liturgical calendar of the Western church. It is usually an evergreen wreath signifying continuous life. It has four candles, 3 purple ones and a pink one for Gaudete Sunday, the 3rd Sunday of Advent. The progressive lighting of the candles symbolizes the expectation and hope surrounding our Lord's first coming into the world and the anticipation of His second coming to judge the living and the dead.
