Mass for Bishop Cancelled

We recently advertised here a Mass to be offered on Monday in St Patrick's Cathedral, Ballarat for the late Bishop Ronald Mulkearns. Last Wednesday we received the following message from Ballarat:


The proposal to offer a Memorial Mass for Bishop Mulkearns has been reconsidered in the light of the level of distress that this proposal has prompted. A public gathering for Mass in an environment of protest would raise concerns for public safety, exacerbate the pain and suffering of victim survivors and compromise the occasion as one of prayer. The Mass for Bishop Mulkearns was proposed in line with the Catholic practice of prayer for those who have died. However, the adverse reaction to the proposal must be listened to and the concerns heeded, so the Mass will not proceed.
