poverty, and I wish to die poor." Pope Pius is unique among popes for preaching a homily every Sunday. He famously lowered the age of First Communion from 12 to 7, insisting that "Holy Communion is the shortest and safest way to Heaven." As the drums of war beat louder and faster in the summer of 1914, Pius became distressed and depressed. On 20<sup>th</sup> August 1914 the news was announced: "The Holy Father has died of a broken heart."
