

Despite the lack of leadership of the church the needs of the community to be faithful to the call of Christ is of great importance. Relying on the promise of Christ and the belief of peoples to included all in the change, encourage by example, keep the boundaries, reflect on what is said, listening and accepting differences. Understand the evolving community and church remembering that we are all equal in the eves of God. Change has happened in the past and will in the future we now need to be in control of that change and make it work for all peoples. The example of lay led communities will be the future. The function of priest in what ever form they take will be difficult to satisfy the differing and expanding expectations. Communities could meet and evaluate the past performance and formulate the future. this is for the whole church, not all are homogeneous groups so listening and acceptance will be paramount to success. We need to train people to deal with the added pressure that will come our way into the future.

Pope Francis left the Vatican on 15 March to embark on a mini-pilgrimage to an icon and to a crucifix associated with miraculous interventions to save the city and its people. The Holy Father laid a bouquet of yellow and white flowers on the altar and sat in prayer in front of the chapel's famous icon of Mary and the child Jesus.
