22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time / Year C 31st August & 1st September 2019

For the past four years, Catholics have accepted the invitation of Pope Francis to join with other Christians across the planet in celebrating the Beason of Creation. This extended celebration of creation was launched in 989 by the Orthodox Patriarch of Constantinople and joined progressively by ther Christian communities. It begins with the World Day of Prayer for Creation on September 1 and concludes on the Feast of St Francis of Assisi. Over this period, we might reflect on what is happening to our planet and pay articular attention to the eighth work of mercy, "care of our common home". As a spiritual work, care of our common home calls us to "grateful ontemplation of God's world". As a corporal work, it calls us to "simple daily estures" that create a more sustainable and equitable world.

Today's gospel calls us to redress imbalances in the human munity, imbalances that have ultimately affected the earth itself. Jesus is er scrutiny as he dines in the home of a leading Pharisee. In Luke's pel, the Pharisees are generally depicted as hostile to Jesus. This portrait ects the situation of the time the gospels are being written when Pharisaic aism and Christian Judaism had parted ways. At the time of Jesus' stry, the Pharisees were a minority group of well-respected experts in the Despite the hostility from his host, Jesus is not deterred from expressing opinion and as usual he does so in the form of a story that comes from the erience of his hearers. He first addresses the guests and then the host. guests are clearly not from the lower echelons of society. They are people receive invitations to wedding banquets where places of honour are erved for the most distinguished guests. Jesus appeals to their fairly nal fear of being shamed before others. He also reminds them of the ciple of reversal that operates in God's kin-dom where those who seek the places find themselves last and the last are first.

Jesus' advice for his host is more removed from first century Palestinian experience than is his advice for the guests: do not invite friends, family and wealthy neighbours; invite the destitute and those with disabilities. In other words, invite those considered unclean by observant Jews rather than those who have the capacity to return your hospitality. This was a confronting

gestion in that culture. If odied the inclusive es of the kin-dom vision Jesus had preached the outset. It is confronting for us in our times. It is easy to welcome like-minded people into our land and our homes. It is not so easy to be open to those who see the world differently from us. We are invited to look on them with love rather than hostility and to secure a place for them in our hearts and in our common home. Veronica Lawson rsm

BALLARAT CLERGY SUPPORT FUND Collection for Sick and Retired Priests

The Ballarat Clergy Support Fund provides for retired priests who have spent a lifetime selflessly caring for others, and who deserve a happy and peaceful retirement. The Fund is currently supporting and caring for fifteen retired priests. Over the next few years a number of priests currently in parish ministry will be moving into retirement, and will also need to be

supported by the fund.

This collection has raised nearly 1.9 million dollars since its inception in 1991, including nearly \$48,000 last year. Along with the priests' own contribution of approximately \$33,000 per year, this annual collection has allowed the Fund to continue to support our sick and retired clergy. Almost 10 percent of rubbish in landfill is packaging. Instead of the hard plastics used in packaging going to landfill, it should be recycled. Please be aware that prepacked items often use a lot of plastic. Recycling plastic will reduce the amount of rubbish going to landfill. Better still is to avoid purchasing prepacked items and take your own non plastic bags or containers for single items eg (fruit and vegies) and so reduce even the recyclable waste!


