The Synod of the Catholic Church

Pope Francis points to eight characteristics of a synodal Church. We continue to examine one each week.

A Humble and Honest Church – A synodal Church acknowledges and seeks to atone for the wounds it has brought to others. It seeks to shatter the culture of clericalism that has wrought grievous harm by distorting the beautiful gift of priesthood into a possession or a caste, with all the sinfulness that such a sense of privilege brings with it. To be a trustworthy Church, transparency is going to need to be an essential component in every level and aspect.
