#### Dear Friends:

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, given to us to be our food and drink for our spiritual life. The gospel reading about the multiplication of the bread and fish already foreshadows the gift of the Eucharist, the body and blood of Christ, Jesus first speaks to the crowd, then feeds them with bread and fish. It is the same in the celebration of the Eucharist: Jesus speaks to us through the readings and gives us himself in the form of a bread. That same Jesus comes to us in his word and the Eucharistic bread. Jesus associates his disciples in the distribution of the food to the crowd. Today he wants the members of the church to be associated with him in bringing his body and blood to the people as their nourishment for eternal life.

So Jesus will provide the food, the Eucharist, but he wants us as the members of his body to help bring the Eucharist to people and the people to the Eucharist. The Lord takes the little that we offer to Him, that is like the five loaves and two fish, and he satisfies the cry of the people. Thinking of the countries that are facing awful problems of poverty and hunger, we might feel that anything we do has little or no value. But Jesus did not turn his back on the five loaves and two fish. He sees our determination to do whatever we can to help. He takes our simple offerings and uses these to provide for more than we could ever imagine. So, let us ask the Lord to give us the heart and mind of Jesus to love and care for the people who need our affection. - Neville

People in faith communities across Australia will also be called to participate locally in their own communal *Listening and Discernment* encounters.
