The Synod of the Catholic Church

Pope Francis points to eight characteristics of a synodal Church. We continue to examine one each week.

A Synodal Church seeks inclusion - All must be welcomed to our Catholic faith with love, as Jesus taught, including people of all races and cultures, the LGBT+ community, married divorced and disabled. Faith-filled parents of LGBT+ children were especially vocal in their call for greater inclusion from the Church, as were young adults.

In addition, the Church must recognise patterns of racism, prejudice and discrimination that still deforms the body of Christ. Many synodal dialogues saw the multicultural identities of our parish and diocesan communities as a rich blessing, but also a challenge.
