



Saint of the Week -

St Thomas Aquinas, priest, doctor (January 28)

Saint Thomas Aquinas was a Catholic Priest in the Dominican Order and one of the most important medieval philosophers and theologians. He was immensely influenced by scholasticism and Aristotle and known for his synthesis of these two traditions. Although he wrote many works of philosophy and theology throughout his life, his most influential work is the *Summa Theologica* which consists of three parts: on God, on ethics and on Christ.
