The Synod of the Catholic Church

Pope Francis points to eight characteristics of a synodal Church. We continue to examine one each week.

A Participative Church where Co-responsibility flourishes – This enables the ability of lay men and women to contribute meaningfully to the breadth of the Church's ministries and apostolates and to the process of renewal and conversion that lie at the heart of synodality.

"We call for the involvement of all who belong to the People of God - laity, consecrated and ordained - to engage in this exercise of deep and respectful listening to one another ... Participation is based on the fact that all the faithful are qualified and are called to serve one another through the gifts they have each received from the Holy Spirit".

Reading the dialogue summaries, it becomes clear that the People of God believe much is lacking in the Church's goal of becoming a participative and co-responsible Church.

Our Diocese turns 150

It was on the 30th March, 1874 that Pope Pius 1X issued a decree that marked the beginning of the Ballarat Diocese. Thus on 30th March, 2024 the Diocese turns 150.

Bishop Paul Bird invites us to mark this significant occasion by using the whole of 2024 as an anniversary year. The Star of the Sea Parish will set aside the 4-5 May as a special weekend in the Parish. We are invited to celebrate our own history and this will vary with our communities who were once parishes in their own right.

Bishop Paul hopes to mark the occasion with a personal visit to each parish during 2024.
