Dear friends, it has been a difficult and horrifying last Sunday and the following week for all in our community. We know that some people have lost their house, property and stock. With all the devastation of the bushfire, we have to thankful to God that there were no serious causalities from the fire. Our prayers and thoughts are with those families, as they go through this difficult time. We hope that they would be strengthened and supported by the grace of God.

This weekend we celebrate Palm Sunday. The liturgy of this Sunday is putting together Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem and his passion, death and resurrection. It reflects also the memorable events and high moments of our faith in receiving our sacraments. We are proud of the sacraments and our Christian life. but, when our faith life is tested and we are asked to carry our cross, we protest and rebel. When our faith and the sacraments demand that we are to serve and love everyone, we step back and complain.

Holy week celebrations make present the Paschal Mystery of Jesus in a sacramental way. With all the suffering, betrayal, denial, crucifixion and death Jesus fulfils His Father's will. He shows us the true love and forgiveness. So we closely go through Jesus' suffering and death in coming days, let us ask the Lord to strengthen our faith so that we may able to carry our own cross and follow Jesus in our witnessing life. - **Neville.**
