
Theodore Roosevelt once said: "People don't care how much you know until they know how much you care."

In a similar vein, Pope Francis has urged Catholics to be willing to show their love for others by welcoming everyone into the Church, including those who disagree with its teachings.

"You do not convince people with arguments, strategies or tactics. You convince them by learning how to welcome them," he said recently. "For that, it is necessary to keep doors open, above all the doors to the heart."

Addressing crowds in Paraguay, the Pontiff said Church leaders and those who worshipped in the Catholic tradition had to "welcome the persecuted, the unemployed the different cultures with which this land is so richly based."


