Plenary Council: Eight major themes have emerged from the 17,000 submissions to the Plenary Council. At a recent Assembly in Sydney that Bishop Paul Bird attended he made the following notes. This week we highlight:

Governance at the Service of Communion, Participation & Mission Governance in the Catholic Church should be exercised in a synodal manner, with the appropriate participation of all the baptised.

- For a Diocese, this would mainly involve the participation of the Diocesan Pastoral Council, the Council of Priests, the College of Consultors, the Diocesan Finance Council, the Diocesan Curia, various boards and governance bodies, and, at times, a Diocesan Synod. Within five years following the closing session of the Plenary Council, each Diocese will conduct a Diocesan Synod
- For a Parish, this would mainly involve the participation of the Parish Pastoral Council and the Parish Finance Committee
