The Synod of the Catholic Church

Pope Francis points to eight characteristics of a synodal Church. This is the final characteristic.

A Synodal Church is a Discerning Church - Discernment is the action of the Holy Spirit leading believers to understand what God is asking of them. Those who have engaged in true discernment realise that listening and openness is necessary in understanding the call of the spirit.

Discernment is the knowledge of the reality that God is in charge. It is committing to discovering the Lord's pathway for our lives, our families and our Church in the openness to God's action rather than our own desires, plans and drives. It is crucial that this stance of openness and discernment characterise the role of all who participate in the synodal processes: bishops, laity, priests, religious and deacons.

NB: The word synodality comes from its Greek roots, *syn* and *odus*, which literally means 'together on the road'. Synodality is about renewal and reform of the Church, in particular by walking together on this journey.

RCIA

This morning David Owen will be welcomed into the Catechumenate (10.30am Mass at St Joseph's). The 'Dismissal' for David will follow. What is this? A Dismissal is a period of time, following the homily, for the catechumen to reflect further on the Word of God guided by two catechists from the parish.

A number of children of catechetical age have also been undertaking a catechetical program in preparation for receiving the sacraments of initiation. Three children received the sacraments of initiation last week at Infant Jesus. Over the next month the remaining children, along with one adult, will receive the sacraments of Confirmation and First Eucharist at varying churches across the parish. We congratulate these new members of our community and extend our ongoing support on their faith journey.
