Plenary Council: Eight major themes have emerged from the 17,000 submissions to the Plenary Council. At a recent Assembly in Sydney, in which Bishop Paul Bird attended, he made the following notes. The last one to highlight is:

Integral Ecology and Conversion for the Sake of our Common Home

Pope Francis' encyclical letter *Laudato Si'* (2015) pointed out that we are "joined in a splendid universal communion" with other creatures and are called to care for the common home which we share with them (n. 220). The Dicastery for the Promotion of Integral Human Development's *Laudato Si'* Action Platform provides a global vehicle for communal action.

- a. By 2024, Dioceses and Parishes will join the *Laudato Si'* Platform
- b. By 2030, Dioceses and Parishes will either develop their own or participate in an established *Laudato Si'* Action Plan
