PLENARY COUNCIL

The Plenary Council process began three years ago. Many parishioners throughout Australia were engaged in the process. The previous Plenary Council was held in 1937.

Some 17,500 submissions were received and considered and these were placed into various themes. The six themes being: Conversion, Prayer, Formation, Structures, Governance and Institutions.

The First Assembly of the Fifth Plenary Council of Australia commenced last Monday. It includes 280 people, both religious and lay. The agenda for the Assembly calls those attending to "develop concrete proposals to create a more missionary, Christ-centred Church in Australia".

Some comments:

- ... the body of our Church is wracked with pain and illness. We might not be expecting miracles during these days of meeting, but we should confidently await blessings, and pray for blessings in abundance. How good it would be if all the People of God could hear a message of hope. (Frank Brennan SJ)
- ... through the Plenary Council, we are being called to consider how we can be a Church that goes out to the peripheries, that welcomes all into our communities and shows the face of Christ to the world. (Archbishop Timothy Costelloe SDB President of the Plenary Council)
- ... What do I hear from those I meet about the Plenary Council? Common themes have been the need for changing a culture of clericalism that infects some sectors of the Church and change in governance; one that actualises lay coresponsibility in union with our priests and bishop. (Marie Shaddock, a Ballarat Diocesan representative attending the Council)
- ... In this week of the First Assembly, I pray that we will be richly blessed with the gifts we need, gifts such as wisdom and courage and patience and love. (Bishop Paul Bird CSsR)
- ... I am suggesting that the episcopal and clerical members of the Council be particularly attentive to the voices of the laity when they address the Council's agenda. (*Bill Uren SJ*)
