# **Pope Francis' General Audience**

Pope Francis used his General Audience this week to plead for peace.

"I pray for those families who have seen a day of celebration turned into a day of mourning and ask for the immediate release of the hostages".

He said that while "it is the right of those who are attacked to defend themselves", he remained deeply concerned by the "total siege facing the Palestinians in Gaza, where there have also been many innocent victims".

Pope Francis continues: "Terrorism and extremism do not help to reach a solution to the conflict between Israelis and Palestinians. but it fuels hatred, violence and revenge, causing suffering to both sides .... The Middle East does not need war but peace, a peace built on justice, dialogue and the courage of fraternity...."

**NB:** Hamas launched a surprise brutal attack on the southern part of Israel as Jews marked the feast of Simchat Torah (Joy of the Torah). Many young people were murdered who were attending an outdoor music festival at the time. Overall about 2,400 people have died in this tragic conflict - mostly innocent people including many women and children.
