Dear friends, This weekend two priests from the Redemptorist Religious Order are going to be with us and celebrating the Eucharist. Their aim is to prepare us for the plenary council by dialogues and discussions. These discussions and dialoques will make us feel that we are part and parcel of the mother church. We are part of the universal church and have the Pope as our head of the church in place of Christ. This unity is essential for the church to continue the mission of Jesus in the world. The gospel reading supports this theme of unity. Here, Jesus compares our relationship with him to a vine and its branches. He is the centre of our foundation. Cutting and detaching ourselves from him will cause us to wither and die. Away from Jesus, we are useless and helpless; we cannot bear fruit. Jesus is our nourishment and our very life. We are called to remain in Jesus to live with him and to be in communion with him. United to Jesus means, we are to be pruned. What is useless and unnecessary in us is cut off. We let go of the excess baggage in our life. The pruning is our self-purification, so that we can be healthy and fruitful for the Lord. We become fruitless branches when we no longer listen to Jesus. We refuse to accept him; we go against his will and rebel against his ways because we are unwilling to forego the comforts and conveniences of our life. We do not bear fruit when we listen to but do not follow his teachings. We pay lip service but do not practice. So let this encounter help us reflect on ourselves and ask the Lord to prune and cut off whatever is unnecessary in our life. Through this self-purification may we be fruitful for the Lord and be able to unite with the mission of the church. - Neville.
