Ordinary Time

This week we move into that time of year known as Ordinary Time.

There are two parts to Ordinary Time:

The first, which we are now entering, falls between the end of the Christmas Season and the start of Lent.

The second falls between Pentecost and prior to the Season of Advent.

- Ordinary Time is in fact the longest season of the Church year.
- It has its own liturgical colour (green) symbolising Christian hope and life.
- As Christians, Sunday is our original feast day, the day to celebrate Christ's resurrection and our participation in the paschal mystery.

Ordinary Time enables us to celebrate the presence of God in the ordinary patterns of human life.

There is nothing Ordinary about Ordinary Time!
