# **Death of Bishop Mulkearns**

Following the death of Bishop R.A. Mulkearns at age 85 last Monday, the present diocesan bishop, Paul Bird issued a statement in which he said among other things "Bishop Mulkearns was the bishop of Ballarat from 1971 till 1997. Those who knew him personally will remember a man who was dedicated in his service over those years and, indeed, over the sixty years he served as a priest. At the same time. Bishop Mulkearns himself acknowledged that he had made some tragic mistakes during his time as bishop. He expressed his sorrow for these mistakes in the evidence he gave to the Royal Commission in February."


