Spanish Reunion

It was in September 2013 that Fr John joined twenty other pilgrims to walk the 660 kms from Loyola to Manresa in the Basque country of Northern Spain. This was the route taken in 1522 by Inigo Lopez de Loyola (who later became St Ignatius of Loyola).

For 30 days we walked through picturesque mountains, deserts and plains before concluding in the town of Manresa (near Barcelona). Ignatius rested in Manresa for some months following his walk. This was a place of profound spiritual enlightenment for him. Here he composed his spiritual masterpiece: the Spiritual Exercises.

Sixteen of the pilgrims will spend today (Sunday) to Tuesday in Warrnambool reminiscing, sharing stories and of course walking a few kilometers and sharing meals. We warmly welcome our pilgrims including one who is travelling from Hong Kong. (*Fr John*)
