A resource and process outlined by the Implementation Plan of the Fifth Plenary Council has recently been published. It is a pastoral study guide of the commitments that conclude the introduction to each Decree, with exploratory questions for



specific and local circumstances. This resource and local reflection are not contingent on the recognition by the Apostolic See and encourages an ongoing synodal pathway. The invitation to continue the synodal journey is offered to all Catholic faith communities, which includes but is not limited to parishes, schools, dioceses, agencies, groups and movements.
