Excerpts from General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops to the People of God

... As Pope Francis requested two years ago, a long process of listening and discernment was initiated, open to all the People of God, no one being excluded, to 'journey together', under the guidance of the Holy Spirit...

For the first time, men and women have been invited, in virtue of their baptism, to sit at the same table to take part, not only in the discussions, but also in the voting process of this Assembly of the Synod of Bishops...we have humbly shared the wealth and poverty of our communities from every continent, seeking to discern what the Holy Spirit wants to say to the Church today...

Our Assembly took place in the context of a world in crisis, whose wounds and scandalous inequalities resonated painfully in our hearts...We prayed for the victims of deadly violence, without forgetting all those who have been forced by misery and corruption to take the dangerous road of migration.

..the Church absolutely needs to listen to everyone, starting with the poorest...It means listening to those who have been denied the right to speak in society or who feel excluded, even by the Church.

... Above all, the Church of our time has the duty to listen, in a spirit of conversion, to those who have been victims of abuse committed by members of the ecclesial body...The Church also needs to listen to the laity, women and men, to the enthusiasm of youth, to their questions and their pleas...The Church needs to listen to families...She needs to welcome the voice of those who want to be involved in lay ministries and to participate in discernment and decision-making structures...
