Reflection

Pope Francis has clearly taken a leaf out of Jesus' playbook. His scathing criticism of 'princes of the church' for self-serving lifestyles is no less trenchant than Jesus' attacks on the religious authorities of his day. It's commonplace now to name clericalism as a prime obstacle to church reform and

a prime obstacle to church reform and renewal. However true, plainly there are two risks involved in this analysis. One, that it does an injustice to clerics who are true servants of the community. The other, that it diverts attention away from our common reluctance to make Jesus' self-emptying our own.

The path of synodality on which Pope Francis has called the whole church doesn't have lanes for 'us' and 'them'. It's a way shared by all.
