Later this year (see dates above) a group of 18 pilgrims will walk the route taken by Inigo Lopez de Loyola in 1522 (who later became St Ignatius of Loyola).

It begins in Loyola (the birthplace of St Ignatius) and finishes in the villages of Montserrat and Manresa. This is in Spain's Basque country. The route proceeds through picturesque mountains, deserts and plains.

Ignatius rested in Manresa for some months following his journey from Loyola. It was a place of profound spiritual enlightenment for him. It was at Manresa where he composed his masterpiece, the Spiritual Exercises. Pilgrims will walk virtually the same route that Ignatius did, pass through many towns that he did, pray at churches where he did, and marvel at the natural wonders that he saw.
