Pastoral Statement from the Diocese

The spread of coronavirus, COVID-19, continues to present challenges to health authorities around the world. Many dioceses have temporarily altered certain practices in the Mass to ensure the health and safety of parishioners. With the wellbeing of all parishioners of our diocese in mind the following directives to all in the Diocese of Ballarat:

- The Body of Christ (the host) can be distributed to all; Communion of the Precious Blood will be for the **celebrant** only;
- Communion will be received only in the hand and **not** on the tongue;
- At the Sign of Peace, parishioners who may feel uncomfortable about shaking hands may wish to exchange with a smile or a bow;
- All ministers of Holy Communion are to use **hand sanitisers** before the distribution of Holy Communion, and are not to physically touch anyone in the act of blessing;
- Holy water fonts are to be **emptied** or removed

These directives are informed by the latest advice from the **Australian Government** of **Health**, and will remain in place until the need for them ceases. Thank you
