Laetare Sunday

This 4th Sunday of Lent was traditionally called Laetare Sunday from the first word in the entrance antiphon of the old Latin Mass. The word means "Rejoice" - it is a quotation from Isaiah 66, which looks to the day when peace will be "flowing like a river" from the hand of the God of Israel. Laetare Sunday is a few days after the midpoint of Lent; it made a break from the severe fasting that used to be part of the Lenten observance and reminded the faithful that Easter was not too far away. We are grateful that we are able to use rose coloured vestments today thanks to the generosity of one of our parishioners.

The Mass of the Oils will be celebrated in St Patrick's cathedral, Ballarat at 6:30 p.m. On Monday 10 April. At this Mass we celebrate the unity and ministry of the ordained priests in the midst of the entire priestly People of God. 
