18th March 2020

Prayerful greetings to the people of God across Victoria,

The Prime Minister announced that non-essential indoor gatherings will be limited to 100 people, effective today.

Given the seriousness of COVID-19, we support this measure as being responsible and sensible, and we encourage everyone to follow public safety guidelines respectfully.

Immediate suspension of public liturgies

All other gatherings are suspended

We are very aware that this restriction will be particularly difficult for families who are planning liturgies such as funerals, weddings and baptisms.

All Catholics in Victoria are dispensed from their Sunday obligation until further notice.

Let us not panic, nor be anxious, nor reduce ourselves to caring only for ourselves.

This is a time to be sensible, practical, prayerful and to share Christ's peace with those who are struggling to feel calm and safe.
