## **Confirmation Candidates**

The sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated this year on the weekend of 15-16 June, the solemn feast of the Blessed Trinity. Today, candidates at Mass will receive a blessing as they continue their preparation for the sacrament.

### **Catholic Education Week**

Catholic Education Week begins in our Diocese of Ballarat today (Sunday). The week's theme is Listen With the Ear of Your Heart. The Catholic Education Office says "This theme aligns well with the preparation for the Plenary Council 2020 which has called on the Catholic Church to use 2019 as a vear of praver, discernment and dialogue - to truly listen with the ear of the heart." On Friday 31st at 10 a.m. Mass will be celebrated in St Pius X Church with the participation of our parish school communities. The usual 9:15 a.m. Mass will not take place that day but everyone is invited to join in at 10.

#### Mass Count

The annual count of members of the congregation at Mass will conclude this weekend. So far, the numbers at Mass on Saturday evenings and Sunday mornings have added up to a few more than 190 people altogether. Ten years ago, in 2009, the numbers topped 300. Congregations in most parishes have declined in that period, but the implications are nevertheless thought provoking.

#### Parish Audit

An audit of St Pius X Parish was carried out last Tuesday morning. The question was whether our policies and practices about child safety are adequate and up to date. Tania Stegemann and Jhu Manalili from Catholic Professional Standards Ltd were the auditors. They came from Melbourne to spend two hours with Father Michael and parish secretary, Louise Dryburgh. Rachel Brown, our Child Safequarding Officer, was unable to attend because of a commitment in Ballarat, but the work that she and Louise had done over a period of months and years before the audit turned out to be invaluable. We are confident we passed with flying colours, but of course we all need to continue to do our part to ensure that West Warrnambool and Dennington are child-safe parishes.

## **Dennington Centenary News**

At the Parish Pastoral Leaders meeting last Tuesday night, Father Michael mentioned that he has agreed that when, on 22 March 2020, St John's School celebrates the achievement of 100 years of Catholic Education in Dennington, the Sunday morning Mass will be celebrated at the school and not in St Pius X Church. (But that's a long way off.) Meanwhile, Mrs Sharon Easley and the rest of the school staff are very pleased with the memorabilia that parishioners have made available and the memories that former students from those long 100 years have provided.
