### **COVID-19 Restrictions**

Requirements in the State of Victoria have recently been eased to some extent, but we still have to pay careful attention to social distancing, while gatherings for worship are restricted to congregations of no more than 10 people. As the Victorian bishops advise in their letter of 13 May, further guidance in this regard is expected to be provided by State authorities at the end of May.
