## The 'Sunday' Collection

Last week I wrote about the 'two' different accounts: the Parish Account and the Presbytery Account. Today I'll concentrate on the Parish Account. The Parish Account is commonly referred to as 'the envelopes' or 'the Planned-Giving program'.

The account is used to fund:

- Pastoral programs;
- Liturgical expenses;
- Repairs and maintenance of all parish properties;
- The salaries of parish staff;
- Administrative costs (phone, photocopier, paper, etc);
- Extra staff from time to time (gardeners, window cleaners, etc);
- Diocesan Levies that fund diocesan operations as well as special costs like seminar education etc:
- Insurance and recurrent property costs such as utilities, rates, etc;
- Loan repayments (if any);
- Funding capital projects such as major refurbishments or acquisitions.

**NB:** Our insurance this year will be a little over \$130,000. Our Planned-Giving income last year was \$262,000. These sums incorporate all our parish communities.

Thank you to the parishioners who do support our parish financially. Next week I will write about the Presbytery Account.
