#### Reflection

As we progress through Eastertide, the readings turn towards the promise of the coming of the Holy Spirit.

In the **First Reading** we see its influence on the discussions to resolve the conflict between the early Christians during the Council of Jerusalem.

The **Second Reading** from the Book of Revelation describes the heavenly Jerusalem with the Lord and the Lamb in its midst, fulfilling all the hopes of Israel.

The **Psalm** is a song of thanksgiving for the blessings the Lord has given us.

In the **Gospel**, Jesus promises that he, together with the Father, will come to dwell in all those who keep his word, and announces the coming of the Spirit. He bestows on us his gift of peace, bringing us comfort and reassurance.

This week, we might want to pray for all those who do not accept the Word of God, or who do not know it in all its forms in their life. We may also ask that the love we feel for the Lord shows itself in loving deeds in our everyday life.

#### Fr John Corrigan

Fr John was born on 1 September 1981 — so he's not as young as he looks! His mother, Carmel, was born and raised in Koroit, the third daughter of Michael and Muriel McElgunn. Fr John is the eldest of nine children, most of whom live and work in Ballarat. Having completed his schooling at St Francis Xavier College and Damascus College in Ballarat, Fr John moved to Melbourne in 2000, where he studied philosophy and law. By the final year of his degree, he had discerned a call to the priesthood, and in 2005 he entered Corpus Christi College. In 2008 he undertook a pastoral year at St Joseph's in Warrnambool, where he also lived and worked as a deacon in 2010

After his ordination to the priesthood in 2011, Fr John's first priestly appointment was to Koroit and Port Fairy, where he assisted Fr Bill over the summer peak. In 2012 he moved to Hamilton. where he worked with Fr Paddy Mugavin — a collaboration which continued when he was assigned to the parishes of Casterton, Coleraine, Edenhope and Harrow in 2014. Last year, these parishes ioined with Hamilton to form the new parish of St Mary MacKillop, Western Border. These experiences will help Fr John in his new role at St Joseph's Warrnambool, Infant Jesus Koroit, and St Patrick's Port Fairy
