ASH WEDNESDAY (February 10)
Ash Wednesday is one of the most important days in our calendar. Mass time 10.00am only. On ASH WEDNESDAY & GOOD FRIDAY, we do not eat meat; and one full meal only, two light meals & NO EATING BETWEEN MEALS. Please note: Sacred Heart Church will have two evening Masses—Tuesday Vigil 6pm and Wednesday evening 6pm.

Decide this week what special thing you are going to do for lent this year. If you put it off, you may end up doing nothing.

Lent is the severe time in the Church's year. Except for funerals and weddings there are no flowers.

The altar and lectern are draped with purple. Towards the end of Lent the statues are covered with purple as well.

There are no bells. The Alleluia is neither sung nor spoken during Lent. There is no Gloria.

In the Romano-Flanagan Rite, we have a special way of beginning Mass each Sunday. AS WITH ADVENT, EVEN MORE WITH LENT: IT IS A SPECIAL TIME IN THE CHURCH'S YEAR, SO LET'S MAKE IT SPECIAL

We give up something we like for the week-days of Lent.

We make a greater effort with prayer. We Make a positive & generous Lent by reaching out to the third world through Project Compassion.

On Ash Wednesday And Good Friday we abstain from meat; as well, on these 2 days we have only one full meal, and 2 very light ones. No eating between meals.
