Focus on the Scriptures

Matthew's Gospel continues Jesus' Sermon on the Mount, where, like Moses, Jesus teaches the community his code of behaviour. What he teaches sounds impossible, but it is what he lived and what some others have also been capable of living. Occasionally, in the midst of terrible wars and atrocities, we hear of people who have been able to rise above their own suffering and rage, to find in themselves the ability, the grace, of forgiveness. Such people speak of being determined not to let others control their lives and that in being able to forgive they find their own integrity and freedom. They become whole.

When Matthew says, 'Be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect', I think this means something like being a whole person. The Greek word used here is 'telos' and it has the sense of completion, of being whole, of having arrived at the end.

With this in mind, Jesus' code of behaviour calls us to be whole people, and this is how we can also be holy people.

Recently I encountered a difficult student in class. His behaviour was poor and at times seemed out of control – he took no notice of my authority as the teacher. I found myself being filled with tension and rage, and of course saw that this student was the cause. When I prayed about this, I began to see that underneath my tension and rage was my own fear. I was afraid that I could not control him, and I was telling myself I should be able to. Eventually I came to see that this self-talk was wrong. There is no way that I can control any other adult, and nor should I see that as a good thing. If this person wanted to behave poorly then he would and all I could do was find my own inner peace with this. Praying with this led me to let go my fear, to be more at peace, and in fact this meant that I was much more at ease in dealing with this student than I had been when I was carrying such tension and anger. I relate this incident as a small example of reclaiming my own wholeness, rather than letting myself be controlled by another. If I am angry, it is my anger. Of course none of this could happen if I had not taken the time to sit with this in prayer, and seek the inner wisdom of God's Spirit.
